GENERAL DESCRIPTION

It is through respectful guidance and support provided by the Team Leader, that Private Contractors support and assist individuals they share their lives with, to live in dignity, achieve personal satisfaction and inter-dependence and participate actively in the social and economic life of their communities.

ESSENTIAL QUALITIES

1. Understands that through the support provided to Private Contractors, individuals with a developmental disability are given opportunities to develop and maintain mutually supportive, interdependent community based relationships.
2. Recognizes this role as vital in accomplishing the mission, vision and philosophy of the Association.

CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT

1. All persons 18 years of age who receive a conditional offer of employment to provide direct support to adults or children through Southern Alberta Community Living Association, must provide a current, clear Criminal Record Check inclusive of a check relating to the Vulnerable Sector.
2. Valid driver’s license and access to a vehicle with \$1,000,000 public liability
3. Valid Emergency First Aid certificate

EXPERIENCE AND EDUCATION

1. A college diploma or a degree in a human service field of study is preferred.
2. Three years experience providing supports to people living independently in the community is preferred.
3. For the right applicant, a combination of education and experience may be considered.

RESPONSIBILITIES

The Team Leader works with 15-25 private contractors who live with independent individuals with developmental disabilities. The agency staff play a key role in assisting the individuals and Private Contractors to determine areas to increase independence and monitors the arrangement to ensure the contract expectations have been met. Team Leaders conduct Support Assessments, Home Studies, arranges introductions for potential roommates, assists in conflict resolution, and maintains agency documentation. The Team Leader liaises with guardians, external agencies, community resources and acts as a resource to the Private Contractor and Individual being supported.

REQUIRED SKILLS

1. Effectively supports others through active listening and solution focused problem solving.
2. Works as an effective team member fostering the goal of expanding the collective knowledge, skills and the abilities of the team.
3. Accepts feedback and constructive criticism, taking responsibility and appropriate action.
4. Strong verbal and written communication skills, time management and knowledge of community resources.
